### **Discover Milngavie**

In 1793 Milngavie's population was estimated at 200, most of whom were employed in bleaching, printing, cotton spinning, papermaking, dyeing the pencilling of cloth and the distilling of whisky at Tambowie Distillery which was destroyed by fire in 1920



The Glasgow and Milngavie Junction Railway opened in August 1863 and was operated by the North British Railway By 2009 it had just under a million passengers annually and now provides services to Edinburgh alongside normal Glasgow services The station is a "B Listed" building
